OhGee Line Expanded

Fire & Water's successful OhGee coffee table is joined now by an endtable and dining/conference table, as well as new recycled glass top options. Like the original coffee table, these designs have bases of blackened steel rods connecting offset elliptical segments to form a flowing composition, curving in three dimensions. Designed originally for a client's updated mid-century modern apartment, the irregular quadrilateral shape of the tops evoke designs of the "boomerang" era.

The glass tops will be available either in clear glass or in an assortment of recycled glass patterns made from a process similar to the recycled glass used in the award-winning Frankie Goes Fluorescent lighting series. The patterns range from nearly translucent glass with opalescent flakes to a striking green and black composition made from recycled automotive glass.
